1. Disclaimer for personal injury while using the Golf Simulator

You are responsible for using the golf simulator safely and as directed below. You must behave sensibly and follow any safety instructions in order to minimise the risk of injury to yourself and others. In the absence of any negligence or other breach of duty by us, the use of the golf simulator is entirely at your own risk.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Hitting indoors carries with it risks that we cannot entirely eliminate. These include the risk of personal injury such as the ball being miss hit at an unusual angle and ricocheting back into the golfer.

Terms of Use

- You must act responsibly and sensibly at all times.
- You <u>must not</u> participate if you are under the influence of alcohol or non-prescription drugs.
- You must follow any safety warnings or instructions displayed or given to you by a member of staff. Please ask a member of staff if you are unclear.
- The safety curtains, the light switches, the projector remote control and the trackman launch monitor are not to be touched. With regard to the computer please only use the mouse and refrain from touching the hard drive.
- Your clubs must be clean to avoid dirt being transferred onto the impact screen.
- Only use the balls provided by the club; these balls are specifically manufactured for launch monitors to capture
 the level of data needed. <u>Do not</u> apply marker lines to the balls, which can damage the screen.
- Only use the plastic tees provided. <u>Do not use</u> wooden tees as these can splinter and damage the screen on impact.
- If the surface of any ball provided by the club becomes visibly tarnished, stop using and report it immediately.
- All shoes <u>must be</u> clean free from grass before use.
- All food and drink must be placed and consumed at a designated lounge table. Ensure that it is not consumed near the strike mat, Launch Monitor or Computer.
- Golfers should always be hitting into the impact screen; use the mouse or touch screen to adjust your aim for your shot (for example to hit sideways out of a bunker).
- Any faults or damage caused to the room or equipment must be reported immediately to Club staff.
- Those under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- If you are having technical issues when using the system, please contact the designated help team for assistance.
- Players should be aware that the area is covered by CCTV for security and safety.
