



As a parent/carer of a Junior member of Whitecraigs Golf Club or, alternatively, a parent/carer of a child who is not a Junior member and who is under the age of 18, you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct.

You should:

- Encourage your child to understand the rules and play within them
- Emphasise fair play and respect the decisions of Club staff and officials
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results
- Never force your child to take part in sport
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding good performances of all.
- Never punish or belittle any child for losing or making mistakes
- Publicly accept officials' judgements
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport
- Use correct and proper language at all times
- Never use threatening or abusive behaviour towards children, officials, coaches or other parents
- Use social media responsibly and according to Club policy
- Always notify the Coach if your child will not be attending or going to be late for a coaching session/competition

Parents/Carers of Juniors of this Club will be required to sign the Club's Code of Conduct for Parents and Carers (the "Code") incorporating the above and by so doing agree that they will comply and ensure that any child in their care will be made aware of the Club's expectations. In return the Parents/Carers have the right to expect the Club to respect the consents referred to in the Code.
