Marking scores for yourself and another player


In the example shown we have 3 players in the competition

Ben iPhone (Left) who will be playing with a handicap of 20 off the White Tees


Andrea Android (Right) who will be playing with a handicap of 28 off the Red Tees

Mike Motorola (Offscreen) who will be playing with a handicap of 17 off the White Tees

We start by "Begin Scoring"



Now we are given the option to record another players score
Select "Yes" to record another players score along with your own
Select "No" to record a score for yourself only



If your club is using Tee Times you will be presented with the other players in your Tee Time so you can easily select who's scorecard you will be marking


If your club does not use Tee Times or the Player you are marking for is not listed you can "Search" for them

In the example below


"Ben iPhone" on the left is going to mark for "Andrea Android" on the right

"Andrea Android" on the right is going to mark for "Mike Motorola" who is offscreen


"Mike Motorola" is going to mark for "Ben iPhone" on the left




Next we confirm the Handicap that our playing partner will be playing from along with the tee they will be playing from




We now confirm our own handicap and which Tee we will be playing from




We can now enter the scores for both players using the plus and minus buttons to increase and decrease the number of shots taken as required, then we use the right and left arrow buttons to navigate forward and backwards through the holes



At any time we can press the "Card" button to see a summary page of all of the scores entered Pressing "Score" will go back to the score input page



Once we have entered all 18 scores we can "Finish" the round




On "Finishing" the round we are presented with the sign off summary screen

The player we have marked for is shown in the top summary box

Our status is shown in the bottom summary box

First we want to "Check scores I've marked for Player"




We are now presented with an opportunity to "Compare Scores" that we have marked for the Player in the "You Entered" column and the scores that "They Entered" for themselves


Any "Mismatches" will be highlighted in RED

If YOU have input the wrong score then click on the incorrect score in the "You Entered" column, adjust accordingly in the "Pop Up"


If they have entered the incorrect score then they will need to go back in the "Card" select the hole and adjust the score, you will then need to click on the incorrect score in the "They Entered" column and select "Refresh" in the "Pop Up"




When the score's match you are now allowed to select the "Sign Card as Marker" button



We are then presented with a signature box that we can sign and save




The summary page is now updated to say that you have signed as the marker




Repeat this process for the rest of the players in the group

You can see the lower summary box has been updated to reflect that our scorecard has been marked by the playing partner


We can now "Check your scores and sign as player"




We can make a final check on our own scorecard and if there are any errors we can "Request Changes" and send the card back to the marker, whereby we both need to use the previous process to fix any incorrect scores




If we are happy with the scores and they are all correct then we can "Sign Card as Player" and save



The Summary page is updated again



When everybody in the group has completed their sign checks and sign offs the summary screen will show that everything has been completed



Selecting the "Exit Scoring" button will return us back to the page whereby we can choose to upload a photograph of the scorecard if required
